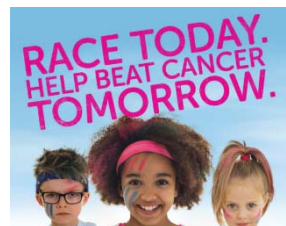

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Newham Immunisation Team- Reception to Year 5

It's that time of year again when the Newham immunisation team have been back to offer children (From Reception to Year 5) the nasal flu vaccine.

Flu is an illness caused by the influenza virus, which is common during the winter months. The vaccination programme is designed to protect your child against flu.

The Immunisation team visited Reception and Years 1 and 2 on **10th October 2018** and will be coming in to visit Years 3, 4 and 5 on **16th October 2018**, helping to protect the children from the flu virus in time for the winter, and helping to protect other family members through not spreading the influenza virus infection.
