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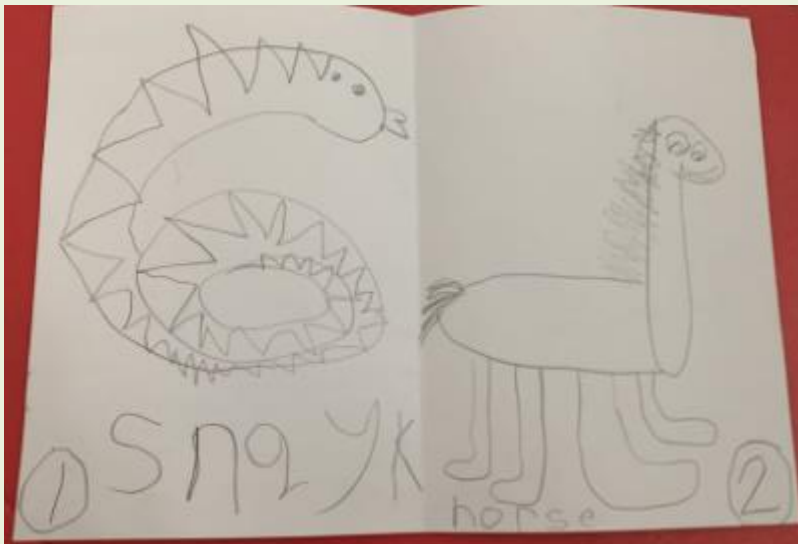
Writing at Vicarage

These include-

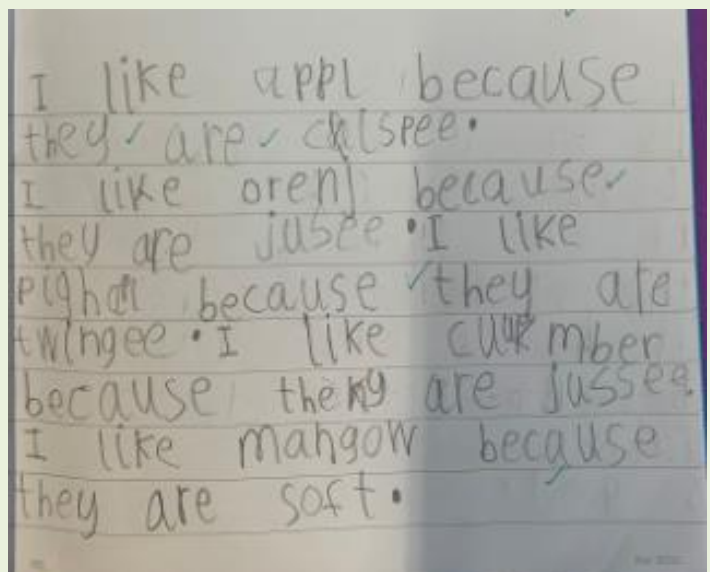
- Pupils being explicitly taught the writing processes (how to generate an idea, plan, draft, revise, edit, publish)
