7th February 2023




Vicarage Primary school took part in Safer Internet Day (SID) 2023 on Tuesday 7th February. Safer Internet Day is celebrated globally in February every year.


The aim is to promote the responsible, safe and positive use of digital technology for children and young people, and to encourage conversation about using technology respectfully, critically, and creatively.
