

















Duties and evenings



What to Pack

- Coat
- Waterproof anorak if you have one.
- Complete changes of underwear and socks (enough for your stay)
- Three warm sweaters or sweatshirts
- Enough shirts, T shirts or similar for your stay (1 per day)
- At least two pairs of trousers or tracksuit bottoms (Please note that jeans are not suitable)
- One pair of trainers or boots that you don't mind getting muddy
- One pair of indoor slippers or extra pair of trainers for indoor use
- Pyjamas
- Two towels
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap flannel, deodorant etc.)
- A plastic carrier bag (for wet/muddy wellington boots)
- Hair bands to tie up long hair if applicable and a hair brush

A torch for the night walk (only if you have one, please do not buy one.)

Personal Items

Please ensure that all valuables such as jewellery and mobile telephones are left at home.

Pocket Money

Up to £5.00. If students wish to make purchases from the Centre's shop, it would be useful to bring change **(coins)** rather than notes.

Medication

Please ensure all medication is labelled with child's name and there is enough to last the length of your stay.

Electrical devices

- Children are **not allowed** to bring mobiles phones, tablets or any electrical devices.
- We will post photos on Twitter so you can keep up-to-date on your child's stay.

Spending money

- Children will not be leaving the site to visit shops.
- Fairplay House has a shop where pupils can buy stationary and other supplies.
- Pupils can bring in **up to £5.00 in an envelope or purse/wallet** with your child's name.
- Please bring coins as there will be limited change available.

Common Questions

- Are there separate areas for the boys/girls? Yes- boys and girls will be in separate areas for sleeping and showering.
- Are the activities safe? Yes. All staff are trained and safety procedures are monitored regularly.
- Is there anywhere to spend money and how much to bring? £5.00 in coins to sue in the centre tuck shop.
- Does the centre cater for my child's dietary needs? Yes, Halal, vegetarian and caters for any allergies.
- What if my child is scared in taking part in any of the activities? Staff are trained to support those who are scared and encourage pupils to join in.
- Will my child be supervised at all times? Yes, apart from sleeping. Staff sleep in separate rooms.
- Can my child bring a mobile phone/camera/handheld electronic games? NO.
- My child needs medication. What should I do? Have it in a bag, labeled with the child's name and dosage instructions. Give this to the teacher on Wednesday 24th January when your child's bags are dropped off.
